VOTING INSTRUCTIONS

December 28, 2015

Dear Palisair Home Owner:

Based on the passage of the CC&R amendments in October 2011, the PHOA is now governed by the Davis-Stirling Act, which, among other things, requires an annual secret ballot for the election of the members to the Palisair Home Owners Association Board of Directors. To be eligible to vote, you must be the legal owner of your home in one of the three PHOA tracts 15944, 15948, or 19890.

Following the 2012 By-Laws changes we now have a staggered Board with three-year terms. Each year, therefore, three Board positions are up for election. This year there are three (3) candidates running for three (3) Board positions. They represent the three PHOA Nominating Committee choices. (See "Biographies of Candidates" page.) If you choose not to vote and would like your ballot to be used only for quorum purposes, please mark "abstain."

The California Civil Code provides a specific procedure to conduct the secret ballot election in order to insure fairness and participation, while insuring that your vote remains confidential. We have enclosed two envelopes in compliance with this procedure.

The ballot itself is not to be signed by you, but once you have completed it, please seal it inside the enclosed small blank envelope and then place that envelope in the second larger envelope, which is addressed to the PHOA Inspector of Elections. In the upper left-hand corner of this second envelope, sign your name on the signature line of the return address label, which shows your address within the Association. Even though you may prepare your ballot at some location other than the property you own within the PHOA, it is important that your signature is under the address of the property you own; this gives you the right to vote. If your name, PHOA address and signature are not on this envelope the Inspector of Elections cannot count it and will show it as voided. Once the Inspector of Elections receives your ballot, it is irrevocable.

The Inspector of Elections will be tabulating the vote to elect directors by Secret Ballot on Monday February 1, 2016, at 7:00 p.m. in a public meeting at the home of Ms. Diana Ungerleider, 16031 Anoka Dr., Pacific Palisades, CA.

We recommend that your ballot be postmarked no later than January 28, 2016, in order to ensure its arrival before the votes are to be counted. The ballot envelopes will not be opened until the meeting referenced above, and then in public. If you are unable to mail your ballot by the deadline provided, you may bring it in person on February 1st. A quorum of members must return ballots in order for the vote to be valid
